We proposed doing this by using a food-safe shipping carrier and using telemedicine to deliver nutrition assessment and counseling to individuals. This proposal is just one of the many ways we are trying to reach those in outlying communities, especially in a large state like New York, where we know 1.3 million people are living in rural counties upstate.

It is the mission of God's Love We Deliver to serve those who are too sick to shop or cook for themselves and we are committed to serving those who are the most sick and isolated in their communities, wherever they are. We hope to achieve this important and life-saving goal through collaboration and future partnerships.
