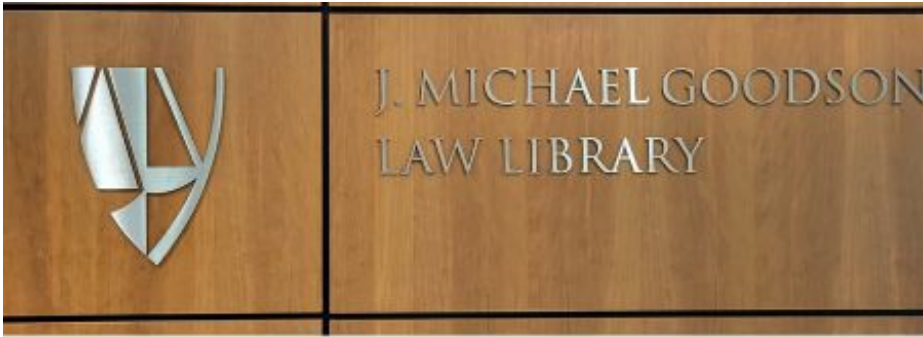


Eileen Schnur, Ward and Smith's Library and Research Services Manager, has recently been elected President of the Raleigh Area Law Librarians Association (RALLA).
