

Mike McIntyre Celebrates Scottish Heritage at the 50th Anniversary of the St Andrew's Society of North Carolina

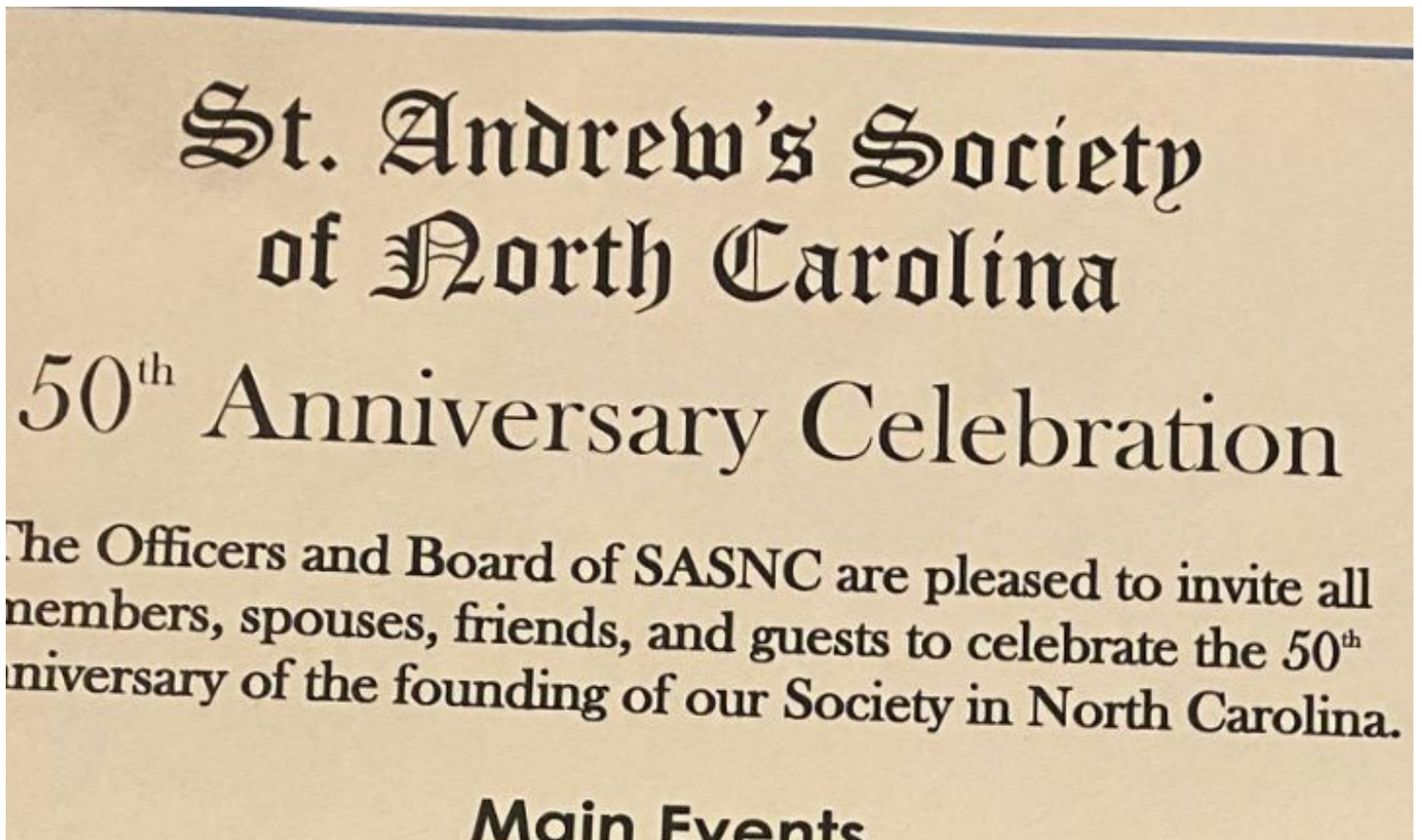
