The Ronald McDonald House of Eastern North Carolina ("RMHENC") is teaming up with WNCT for an all-day telethon to benefit both RMHENC locations in Greenville. Last year, the 2nd Annual RMH Telethon raised \$23,000, and this year, organizers have set a new target of
