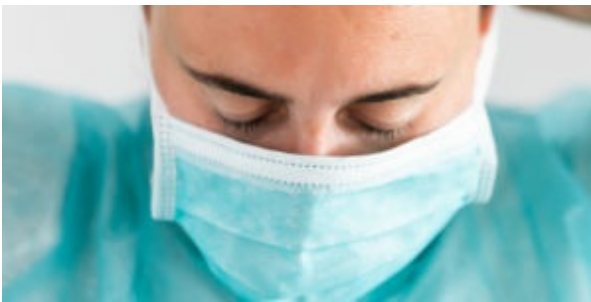

The Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act (CARES) – Legal Immunity To Volunteer Health Care Providers

On Friday, March 27, 2020, The Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act (CARES) was signed into law.
