- Who is subject to the mandate?

- Who will pay for any costs of vaccination?
- What proof of vaccination is required and what documentation must be supplied?
- When and where must alternative testing (if allowed) be done?
- When and how should results of testing be reported to the employer?
- Why might an employee qualify for an exemption and what documentation is required?
