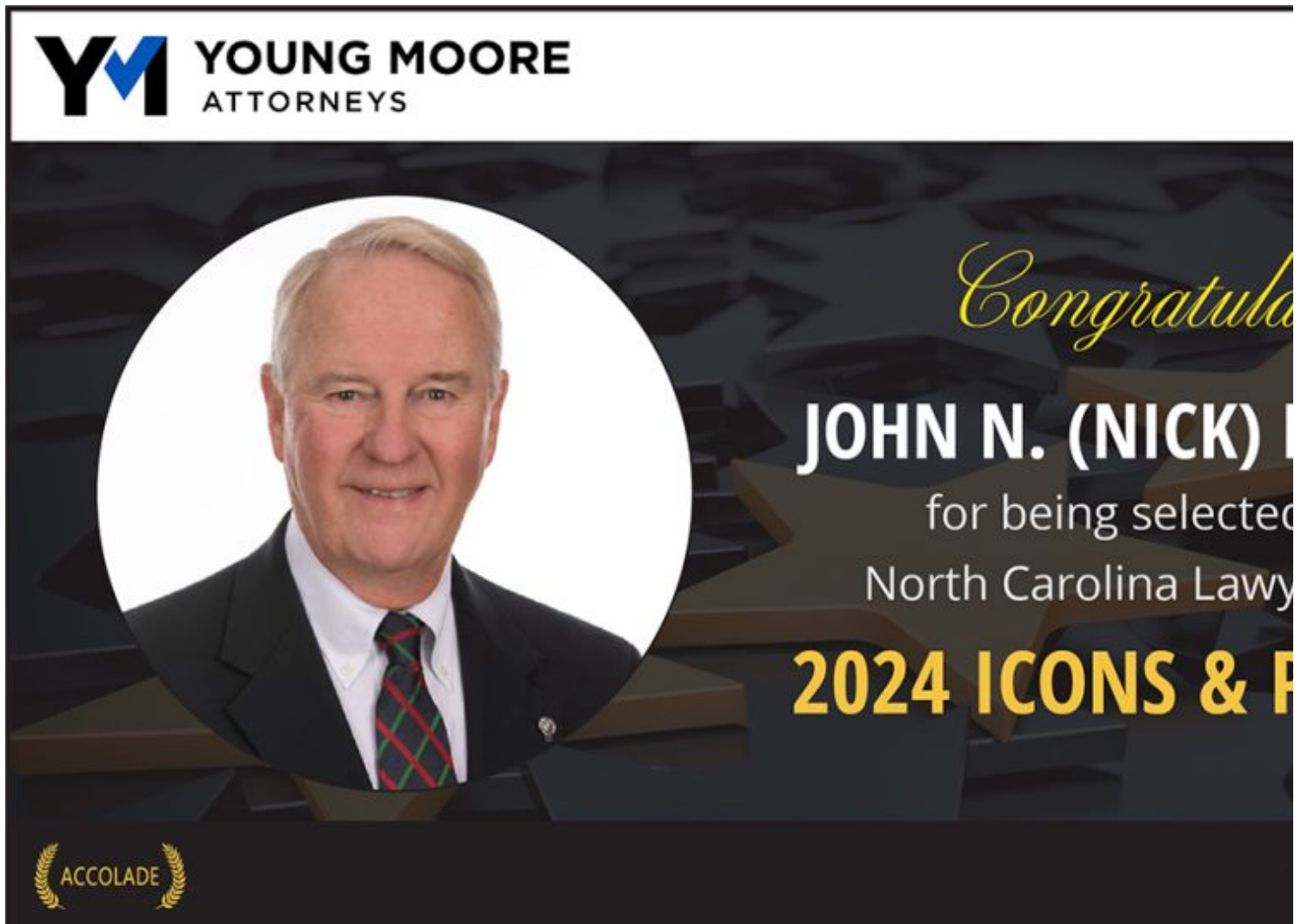

Nick Fountain Named 2024 Icon by North Carolina Lawyers Weekly
