She is certified by the American Board of Family Medicine and the American Osteopathic Board of Family Physicians.

Recognized as an advocate for and leader of the osteopathic medical profession in North Carolina, Dr. Walker has

served as a trustee of both the American Osteopathic Association and of Campbell University.

Dr. Walker also has a distinguished military career spanning more than 20 years in the U.S. Army where she served active duty in Operation Desert Shield/Desert Storm attached to the 307th Medical Battalion of the 82nd Airborne. She has the distinction of being the first female physician ever to deploy with that Division. She retired from the military in 2006 with the rank of Colonel.
